- Application and Club Endorsement deadline: 12:00 pm Noon, Monday, October 14, 2024

- Commitment to community service
- Well defined and realistic goals for academic and professional future
- Plan to pursue a career in one of *Rotary's seven areas of focus*

Applicant Eligibility

- Proficient in language the proposed course of study is taught
- Program of study at the graduate level
- Willing to live in immediate vicinity of study institution
- Willing to participate with a host Rotary Club and Rotary District
- Will participate in required pre-departure (Summer 2025) Scholar Orientation Forum in Atlanta
- Only for new programs of study not already underway
- May not be: 1) a Rotarian; 2) an employee of a club, district, or any other Rotary entity; 3) the spouse, lineal descendant, parent, or grandparent of any person in the first 2 groups
- May be a Rotaract member
- Must have legal residence, be employed full time, or be a full-time student in the state of Georgia, USA
- Must have the endorsement of a District 6900 Rotary Club
- Must be a citizen of the United States of America
